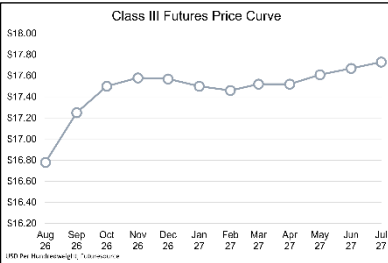
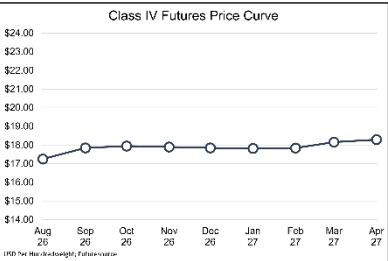
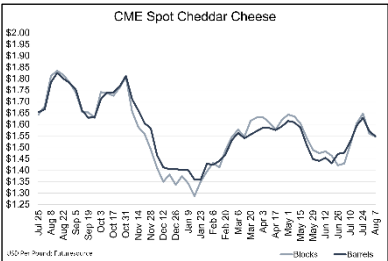




Weekly Dairy Market Report

Aug. 7, 2026

- CME butter ended the week just \$0.0025 lower than last Friday, closing at \$1.5125 per pound. Supply is plentiful, and a record 79 loads traded at the CME on Thursday. NDM closed Friday at \$1.5775 per pound, up \$0.0175 on the week. Spot blocks eased \$0.0175 from last Friday to \$1.5550 per pound, while barrels held steady at \$1.5475 per pound.
- USDA’s June Dairy Products report confirmed ample cheese and butter supplies. Total cheese production climbed to 1.23 billion pounds, up 1.1% versus 2025, and butter production increased 8.5% on the year to 208.2 million pounds. Trade data for June showed continued strength in exports. US cheese exports reached another record monthly volume of 142.4 million pounds, up 23.8% from last year. US butter exports totaled 19.2 million pounds, up 35.2% versus last June, while outbound NDM+SMP slipped to 105.8 million pounds, 19.1% lower than last year.
- The September corn contract fell to \$4.3900 per bushel, down \$0.0175 from last Friday, while August soybeans closed at \$11.5650 per bushel, \$0.1550 lower on the week.
- US employers cut 23,000 positions in July, below expectations for +88,000 and the first decrease since February. Unemployment came in at 4.1%, down from 4.2% in June.
